  6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article 15 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by
   8 adding a new section to read:
- 9 "§ 153A-274.1. Cable television systems.

10 (a) The term 'city' as used in Article 16 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes shall

11 be deemed to include a county, to the end that counties may exercise the same powers as cities 12 with respect to the acquisition, construction, establishment, enlargement, improvement,

13 maintenance, ownership, operation, and contracting for the operation of cable television

14 systems as authorized by G.S. 160A-311(7).

15 (b) <u>References to a 'city' or 'municipality' in G.S. 40A-3, 40A-42, 132-1.1, 160A-199,</u>

- 16 <u>160A-209</u>, and 160A-319 that relate to cable television systems are deemed also to refer to a
   county."
