1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT
3 CONSOLIDATED CALENDARS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-84.2 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(d1) Consolidated Calendar. – Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (d) of this section, a
7 local board of education may elect to save money by consolidating the school calendar. The
8 consolidated calendar shall include a minimum of 180 days or 1,000 hours of instruction
9 covering at least nine calendar months.

10 If a local board of education complies with this subsection by scheduling 1,000 hours of
11 instruction on less than 180 days, teachers employed for a 10-month term are deemed to have
12 been employed for 180 instructional days."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
