<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 131E-159 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
" <u>(h)</u> <u>A</u>	n individual who is required under Article 27A of Chapter 14 of the	General
Statutes to register as a sex offender shall not be granted EMS credentials and shall not have		
the person's EMS credentials renewed."		
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
