4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new			
6	section to read:			
7	" <u>§ 115C-105.42. Personal learning plans for certain students.</u>			
8	(a) <u>A personal learning plan is a document that provides an ongoing record of a</u>			
9	student's interests, strengths, needs, learning styles, and progress. It is created by, and is the			
10	responsibility of, the student to update in grade six through high school graduation. At a			
11	minimum, the personal learning plan shall ensure that a student evaluates his or her strengths,			
12	weaknesses, short- and long-term goals, accomplishments, and provides input into his or her			
13	own conception of a quality education. Each student who does not have an individualized			
14	education program as defined in G.S. 115C-106.3 or a personal education plan in accordance			
15	with G.S. 115C-105.41 shall have a personal learning plan.			
16	(b) Loca	l education authorities shall develop and deliver the pe	rsonal learning plan	
17	template and process. Students shall be responsible for plan creation and maintenance with			
18	updates as they	leem necessary.		
19	(c) The	purpose of a personal learning plan is for an applicable	student to promote	
20	independent lear	ning at school, home, and in the community by:		
21	<u>(1)</u>	Setting realistic goals and identifying persons who can	n help achieve these	
22		goals.		
23	<u>(2)</u>	Developing strategies for dealing with goals that are not	achieved or are only	
24		partially achieved.		
25	<u>(3)</u>	Recording achievements beyond a purely subject-based	focus.	
26	<u>(4)</u>	Ensuring a dialogue with teachers regarding progress.		
27	<u>(5)</u>	Facilitating communication between parents and teacher		
28		rsonal learning plan shall include self-assessment by an a	* *	
29	personal interests, strengths, needs, and learning styles soon after entry into grade six, forming			
30	the starting point of the plan. For students not attending North Carolina schools in the sixth			
31	grade, a personal learning plan shall be developed as soon as practicable.			
32		rsonal learning plan may include the following:		
33	<u>(1)</u>	The student's evaluation of the curriculum and of	community learning	
34		opportunities and plans for using these resources.		
35	<u>(2)</u>	Learning targets and goals, agreed upon by the stu		
36		parents, including strategies for attainment and achiev	ement in academics,

2	communication technology, and career options.				
3	(3) An outline of the main responsibilities of the school, the parents, and	the			
4	student in achieving learning targets and goals.
