A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE CERTAIN TAX INCIDENCE REPORTS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 105-256(a) is amended by adding the following new subdivision to read: "(a) Publications. – The Secretary shall prepare and publish the following: (2b) By March 1 of each odd-numbered year, a report on the overall incidence of the income tax, sales and excise taxes, and property tax. In addition, the Secretary shall prepare for a finance committee, within 15 days of a request of a member of the committee, an impact analysis report of a bill to change the tax system that would increase, decrease, or redistribute tax by more that twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000).
