A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
INSTRUCTION FOR THE CHILD NUTRITION PROGRAM TO ELIMINATE THE
STUDENT COST FOR REDUCED-PRICE BREAKFAST IN ORDER TO INCREASE
BREAKFAST PARTICIPATION, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE HOUSE SELECT
COMMITTEE ON CHILDHOOD OBESITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
Public Instruction the sum of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) for the
2012-2013 fiscal year to eliminate the student cost of reduced-price breakfast for children who
qualify for reduced-price meals in each local school administrative unit. The goal of
appropriating these funds is to increase breakfast participation.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2012.
