Military Personnel and Their Dependents. – A member of the armed forces of the United States stationed at a military facility in North Carolina, his spouse, and any dependent under 18 years of age residing with him are deemed residents of the State, of the county in which they live, and also, if different, of any county in which the military facility is located. A member of the armed forces of the United States on active duty outside the State of North Carolina shall be deemed an individual resident of the State for purposes of the hunting, fishing, trapping, and special activity license requirements of Article 21 of Chapter 113 of the General Statutes and the Coastal Recreational Fishing License requirements of G.S. 113-174.2.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2011.
