2 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE DUE DATE FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA TURNPIKE
3 AUTHORITY ANNUAL AUDIT REPORT TO OCTOBER, AS RECOMMENDED BY
4 THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6 "**§ 136-89.193. Annual plan of work; annual and quarterly reports.**
7 (a) Annual Plan of Work. – The Authority shall annually develop a plan of work for the
8 fiscal year, describing the activities and projects to be undertaken, accompanied by a budget.
9 This annual plan of work shall be subject to the concurrence of the Board of Transportation.
10 (b) Annual Reports. – The Authority shall, promptly following the close of each fiscal
11 year, submit an annual report of its activities for the preceding year to the Governor, the
12 General Assembly, and the Department of Transportation. ~~Each report shall be accompanied by~~
13 ~~an~~ The annual audit of its books and accounts shall be submitted to the Governor, the
14 General Assembly, and the Department of Transportation when completed in October of each
15 year.
16 (c) Semiannual Reports. – The Authority shall submit semiannual reports to the Joint
17 Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee, and more frequent reports if requested. The
18 reports shall summarize the Authority's activities during the preceding six months, and shall
19 contain any information about the Authority's activities that is requested by the Committee.
20 (d) Report Prior to Let of Contracts. – The Authority shall consult with and report to the
21 Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee and the Joint Legislative Commission on
22 Governmental Operations prior to the letting of any contract for Turnpike Project construction
23 authorized under G.S. 136-183(a)(2).
24 (e) Repealed by Session Laws 2011-145, s. 28.35(a), effective July 1, 2011."
25 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
