Notwithstanding any provision of the North Carolina State Building Code or any general or local law to the contrary, the Carrboro Board of Aldermen may by 7 ordinance adopt and the Town of Carrboro may enforce within its corporate limits and 8 9 extraterritorial planning jurisdiction the 2012 Energy Conservation Code and 2012 Residential Code approved by the North Carolina Building Code Council at its meeting on December 14, 10 2010. 11
