A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWNS OF CORNELIUS, DAVIDSON, HUNTERSVILLE,  
MOORESVILLE, AND TROUTMAN TO ENFORCE MUNICIPAL NOISE  
ORDINANCES ADOPTED BY THE TOWNS ON THE WATERS OF LAKE NORMAN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** If a municipality has adopted a noise ordinance pursuant to Chapter 160A of the General Statutes, it may enforce the noise ordinance, except boat engine noise, on the waters of Lake Norman extending 2,500 feet from the 760-foot elevation line on the shore within, and adjacent to, the municipal corporate limits. A municipality shall not enforce any municipal noise ordinance pursuant to this act if the noise ordinance conflicts with the provisions of Chapter 75A or Chapter 113 of the General Statutes.

**SECTION 2.** This act applies to the Towns of Cornelius, Davidson, Huntersville, Mooresville, and Troutman.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
