The Commission shall specifically consider the statutory models for the following: Sanitary Districts (Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 130A of the General (1) Statutes). (2) Water and Sewer Authorities (Article 1 of Chapter 162A of the General Metropolitan Water Districts (Article 4 of Chapter 162A of the General (3) Statutes). (4) Metropolitan Sewerage Districts (Article 5 of Chapter 162A of the General Statutes). County Water and Sewer Districts (Article 6 of Chapter 162A of the General (5) Statutes). Any other similar organizations that provide water or sewer service in the (6) State. **SECTION 1.(b)** The Commission shall determine whether, how, and to what extent the number of statutory models should be reduced and consolidated. In making these
