Short Title: State Funds for Schools Do Not Revert. (Public)

2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT STATE FUNDS ALLOTTED TO LOCAL SCHOOL  
3 ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS DO NOT REVERT AT THE END OF EACH FISCAL  
4 YEAR.  
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
6 SECTION 1. G.S. 143C-1-2(b) reads as rewritten:  
7 "(b) Reversions. – Unless otherwise provided by law, at the end of the fiscal year the  
8 unexpended, unencumbered balance of an appropriation reverts to the fund from which the  
9 appropriation was made; except that (i) an appropriation to the General Assembly shall not  
10 revert unless otherwise provided by the Legislative Services Commission, (ii) an appropriation  
11 for a capital improvement project shall revert as provided by G.S. 143C-8-11, ~~and~~ (iii) an  
12 appropriation for the implementation of information technology (IT) projects shall not revert  
13 until the project is implemented or ~~abandoned~~, and (iv) an appropriation for  
14 allotment to local school administrative units and charter schools shall not revert."  
15 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective June 30, 2013.
