The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. G.S. 143B-721(d) reads as rewritten:
"(d) The granting, denying, revoking, or rescinding of parole, the authorization of
work-release privileges to a prisoner, or any other matters of business coming before the
Commission for consideration and action shall be decided by a majority vote of the full
Commission. a three-member panel of the members of the Commission."
