SENATE BILL 213

Short Title: Parole Commission Voting. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS FOR VOTING BY THE POST-RELEASE  
SUPERVISION AND PAROLE COMMISSION ON MATTERS COMING BEFORE THE  
COMMISSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 143B-721(d) reads as rewritten:

"(d) The granting, denying, revoking, or rescinding of parole, the authorization of work-release privileges to a prisoner, or any other matters of business coming before the Commission for consideration and action shall be decided by a majority vote of ~~the full Commission~~ a three-member panel of the members of the Commission."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to actions taken by the Post-Release Supervision and Parole Commission on or after that date.
