Short Title: State Highway Patrol Secondary Employment. (Public)

Sponsors: Senators Bingham, Goolsby, and Newton (Primary Sponsors).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY PATROL SHALL
3 BE ALLOWED TO ENGAGE IN CERTAIN SECONDARY EMPLOYMENT.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. Article 4 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding
6 a new section to read:

7 "§ 20-187.4. Secondary employment.

8 A member of the State Highway Patrol, subject to the approval of his or her commanding
9 officer, shall be allowed to engage in any secondary employment that does not directly or
10 indirectly create a conflict of interest with the Patrol or impair the member's ability to perform
11 all expected duties. Permitted types of secondary employment include providing security at
12 sporting events and providing security for events benefitting elementary and secondary schools
13 and institutions of higher learning. Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow a member
14 to engage in secondary employment that requires the member to testify in court or make arrests.
15 The Secretary of Public Safety shall adopt orders, rules, and regulations that are consistent with
16 the provisions of this section."

17 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
