

1 SECTION 4. Any business or other matter undertaken or commanded by the 2 former State Personnel Commission, State Personnel Director, or Office of State Personnel 3 regarding any State program, office, or contract or pertaining to or connected with their 4 respective functions, powers, obligations, and duties that are pending on the date this act 5 becomes effective may be conducted and completed by the Commission, Director, or Office in 6 the same manner and under the same terms and conditions and with the same effect as if 7 conducted and completed by the former commission, director, or office. 8

SECTION 5. This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
