A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT TO MODERNIZE THE STATE PERSONNEL ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.(a)** Chapter 126 of the General Statutes, the State Personnel Act, is hereby renamed and may be cited as the "North Carolina Human Resources Act."

**SECTION 1.(b)** The following entities and positions created by Chapter 126 of the General Statutes are hereby renamed by this act:

- (1) The State Personnel Commission is renamed the "North Carolina Human Resources Commission."
- (2) The Office of State Personnel is renamed the "North Carolina Office of State Human Resources."
- (3) The State Personnel Director is renamed the Director of the North Carolina Office of State Human Resources.

**SECTION 1.(c)** Modification of References. – The Revisor of Statutes shall delete any reference in the General Statutes to the State Personnel Act, State Personnel Commission, the State Personnel Director, or the Office of State Personnel, or any derivative thereof, and substitute references to the North Carolina Human Resources Act, the State Human Resources Commission, the Director of the Office of State Human Resources, and the Office of Human Resources created by this act wherever conforming changes are necessary. 43 **SECTION 2.** The terms of the members of the State Personnel Commission in  
44 effect on June 30, 2013, shall continue on as terms on the State Human Resources Commission.

45 **SECTION 3.** No action or proceeding pending on July 1, 2013, brought by or  
46 against the State Human Resources Commission (Commission), the Director of the Office of  
47 State Human Resources (Director), or the Office of State Human Resources (Office) shall be  
48 affected by any provision of this act, but the same may be prosecuted or defended in the name  
49 of the Commission, Director, and Office. In these actions and proceedings, the Commission,  
50 Director, or Office shall be substituted as a party upon proper application to the courts or other  
51 public bodies.

1           **SECTION 4.** Any business or other matter undertaken or commanded by the  
2 former State Personnel Commission, State Personnel Director, or Office of State Personnel  
3 regarding any State program, office, or contract or pertaining to or connected with their  
4 respective functions, powers, obligations, and duties that are pending on the date this act  
5 becomes effective may be conducted and completed by the Commission, Director, or Office in  
6 the same manner and under the same terms and conditions and with the same effect as if  
7 conducted and completed by the former commission, director, or office.

8           **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
