A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA SHALL PROHIBIT THE ASSIGNMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE OPPOSITE SEX TO THE SAME DORMITORY ROOM, DORMITORY SUITE, OR CAMPUS APARTMENT UNLESS THE STUDENTS ARE SIBLINGS OR LEGALLY MARRIED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Part 3 of Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

**"§ 116-40.11. Prohibit assignment of members of the opposite sex to same dormitory room, suite, or campus apartment.**

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, The University of North Carolina shall prohibit the assignment of members of the opposite sex to the same dormitory room, dormitory suite, or campus apartment unless the students are siblings or they are legally married and there is a valid marriage license on file at the campus housing office that documents the marriage."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to housing assignments for the 2013 fall academic semester and each subsequent semester.
