HOUSE BILL DRH10491-TAz-10* (03/15)

Short Title: NC-PreK Conforming Change. (Public)

Sponsors: Representatives Dobson, Jeter, Malone, and Earle (Primary Sponsors).

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO MAKE CONFORMING CHANGES BY REMOVING OBSOLETE REFERENCES
3 TO THE MORE AT FOUR PROGRAM IN THE GENERAL STATUTES, AS
4 RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ON
5 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-242 reads as rewritten:

8 **"§ 115C-242. Use and operation of school buses.**

9 Public school buses may be used for the following purposes only, and it shall be the duty of
10 the superintendent of the school of each local school administrative unit to supervise the use of all
11 school buses operated by such local school administrative unit so as to assure and require
12 compliance with this section:

13 (1) A school bus may be used for the transportation of pupils enrolled in and
14 employees in the operation of the school to which such bus is assigned by the
15 superintendent of the local school administrative unit. Except as otherwise
16 herein provided, such transportation shall be limited to transportation to and
17 from such school for the regularly organized school day, and from and to the
18 points designated by the principal of the school to which such bus is assigned,
19 for the receiving and discharging of passengers. No pupil or employee shall be
20 so transported upon any bus other than the bus to which such pupil or employee
21 has been assigned pursuant to the provisions of this Article: Provided, that
22 children enrolled in a Headstart program or any ~~More at Four~~ NC Pre-K
23 program may be transported on public school buses, and any additional costs
24 associated with such contractual arrangements shall be incurred by the
25 benefitting Head Start or ~~More at Four~~ NC Pre-K program: Provided further,
26 that children with disabilities may be transported to and from the nearest
27 appropriate private school having a special education program approved by the
28 State Board of Education if the children to be transported are or have been
29 placed in that program by a local school administrative unit as a result of the
30 State or the unit's duty to provide such children with a free appropriate public
31 education.

34 **"§ 143B-168.12. North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc.; conditions.**
