Short Title: Correction Enterprises/Medicaid Sales. (Public)

2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CORRECTION ENTERPRISES TO SELL EYEGLASSES FOR
3 USE BY MEDICAID AND NC HEALTH CHOICE RECIPIENTS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 148-132 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 148-132. Distribution of products and services.

7 The Section of Correction Enterprises of the Division of Adult Correction is empowered
8 and authorized to market and sell products and services produced by Correction Enterprises to
9 any of the following entities: following:

- 10 (1) Any public agency or institution owned, managed, or controlled by the State.
- 11 (2) Any county, city, or town in this State.
- 12 (3) Any federal, state, or local public agency or institution in any other state of
13 the union.
- 14 (4) An entity or organization that has tax-exempt status pursuant to section
15 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Products purchased by an entity
16 pursuant to this subdivision may not be resold.
- 17 (5) Any current employee or retiree of the State of North Carolina or of a unit of
18 local government of this State, verified through State-issued identification,
19 or through proof of retirement status, but purchases by a State or local
20 governmental employee or retiree may not exceed two thousand five
21 hundred dollars (\$2,500) during any calendar year. Products purchased by
22 State and local governmental employees and retirees under this section may
23 not be resold.
- 24 (6) Private contractors when the goods purchased will be used to perform work
25 under a contract with a public agency.
- 26 (7) A licensed health professional for the sole purpose of providing eyeglasses
27 to enrollees in the North Carolina Medical Assistance Program (Medicaid)
28 or the North Carolina Health Insurance Program for Children (NC Health
29 Choice) at no more than the health professional's cost of acquisition. When
30 submitting an order to Correction Enterprises pursuant to this subdivision, a
31 health professional shall include the program identification number of the
32 enrollee to whom the eyeglasses are being provided."

33 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
