Short Title: LRC/Homeland Sec. & Legislative Security. (Public) Sponsors: Representative Pittman. Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY HOMELAND SECURITY ISSUES IN NORTH CAROLINA AND SECURITY AT THE LEGISLATIVE COMPLEX. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission (LRC) shall study Homeland Security issues affecting North Carolina and shall study security at the North Carolina legislative complex. As part of its study, the LRC shall examine all of the following: Homeland security issues that affect North Carolina or that are anticipated to affect North Carolina in the future. (2) Resources available to address those issues. (3) The adequacy of current security measures at the North Carolina General Assembly. How those security measures compare with those taken at legislatures in (4) other states. **SECTION 2.** The LRC shall report its findings, together with any proposed

legislation, to the 2016 Regular Session of the 2015 General Assembly upon its convening.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
