## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT RULES ALLOWING THE PROVISION OF CERTAIN DRIVER EDUCATION INSTRUCTION BY ELECTRONIC MEANS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-215 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

7 "(b1) To the extent practicable, and notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, driver education instruction required under subdivisions (1), (2), and (4) of subsection (b) of 8 this section and any other provision of law may be provided by electronic means. The State 9 10 Board of Education shall adopt rules to permit local boards of education to develop and provide driver education instruction by electronic means in accordance with this subsection, including 11 permitting local boards of education to enter into contracts with public or private entities to 12 13 develop and provide driver education instruction by electronic means. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed as authorizing the use of electronic means to satisfy any part of 14 driver education instruction requiring actual driving experience." 15

16 **SECTION 2.** No later than June 1, 2015, the State Board of Education, in 17 consultation with the Division of Motor Vehicles, shall adopt temporary rules to implement 18 Section 1 of this act.

19 SECTION 3. For school years beginning prior to the effective date of rules 20 adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to Section 2 of this act, a program developed 21 by a local board of education, or a public or private entity contracting with the local board of education, to provide driver education instruction by electronic means shall be deemed to 22 comply with G.S. 115C-215(b1), as enacted by Section 1 of this act, and may be implemented 23 by the local board of education for that school year. For all other school years, the program 24 developed by a local board of education, or a public or private entity contracting with the local 25 26 board of education, to provide driver education instruction by electronic means shall conform 27 to rules adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to Section 2 of this act.

28 SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with
29 the 2015-2016 school year.
