assist motorists or law enforcement officers with wrecked or disabled vehicles, or(ii) is a		
vehicle-being used to install, maintain, or restore utility service, including electric, cable,		
telephone, communications, and gas, (iii) is being used in the collection of refuse, solid waste,		
or recycling, or (iv) is a highway maintenance vehicle owned and operated by or contracted by		
the State or a local government, government and is operating an amber-colored flashing light		
authorized by G.S. 20-130.2. Violation of this subsection shall be negligence per se."		



SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2015, and applies to offenses
