A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES TO ALLOW ACTIVATION OF PARKING METER COINS, TOKENS, CASH, CREDIT CARDS, DEBIT CARDS, OR OT ELECTRONIC MEANS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-301 reads as rewritten: "S 160A-301 Parking."	
"§ 160A-301. Parking. (a) On-Street Parking. – A city may by ordinance regulate, restrict, and prohib parking of vehicles on the public streets, alleys, and bridges within the city. When parking permitted for a specified period of time at a particular location, a city may install a particular that location and require any person parking a vehicle therein to place the me operation for the entire time that the vehicle remains in that location, up to the maximum allowed for parking there. Parking meters may be activated by coins or tokens. coins, to cash, credit cards, debit cards, or electronic means.
