for taking of	coyotes and foxes with weapons and by trapping during the trapping season set by the
Wildlife R	esources Commission each year, with no tagging requirements prior to or after sale.
	<b>SECTION 2.</b> No bag limit applies to foxes or coyotes taken under this act.
	<b>SECTION 3.</b> G.S. 113-133.1(e) reads as rewritten:
