HOUSE BILL DRH30489-MMY-142

Short Title: Const. Amendment - Require Photo ID to Vote. (Public)

Sponsors: Representatives T. Moore, Lewis, Presnell, and Sauls (Primary Sponsors).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE NORTH CAROLINA CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE PHOTO  
3 IDENTIFICATION TO VOTE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 2 of Article VI of the Constitution of North Carolina is  
6 amended by adding a new subsection to read:

7 "(4) Photo identification for voting in person. Every person offering to vote in person shall  
8 present photo identification before voting in the manner prescribed by law."

9 **SECTION 2.** The amendment set out in Section 1 of this act shall be submitted to  
10 the qualified voters of the State at a statewide general election to be held in November of 2018,  
11 which election shall be conducted under the laws then governing elections in the State. Ballots,  
12 voting systems, or both may be used in accordance with Chapter 163A of the General Statutes.  
13 The question to be used in the voting systems and ballots shall be:

14 "[ ] FOR [ ] AGAINST  
15 Constitutional amendment to require voters to provide photo identification before  
16 voting."

17 **SECTION 3.** If a majority of votes cast on the question are in favor of the amendment  
18 set out in Section 1 of this act, the Bipartisan State Board of Elections and Ethics Enforcement  
19 shall certify the amendment to the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State shall enroll the  
20 amendment so certified among the permanent records of that office.

21 **SECTION 4.** The amendment set out in Section 1 of this act is effective upon  
22 certification.

23 **SECTION 5.** Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes  
24 law.
