5	SECT	TON 1.(a) Section 1 of Chapter 1248 of the Session Laws of 1971 reads as	
6	rewritten:		
7	"Section 1. S	Should a vacancy exist on the Board of Aldermen-City Council of the City of	
8	Winston-Salem b	y death, resignation, or otherwise than by expiration of term, and should the	
9	unexpired term at	t the time the vacancy occurs be for twelve months or more, then the Forsyth	
10	County Executive Committee of each political party shall immediately designate a candidate for		
11	said vacancy and the Board of Aldermen City Council shall adopt a resolution calling for a special		
12		tion, cause to be held, in the Ward which the vacating Alderman member	
13	represented, an election to fill said vacancy vacancy for the unexpired term. With respect to a		
14	resignation, a vacancy is deemed to exist once the City Council accepts a resignation of a		
15	member, even if the effective date of the resignation is a future date. The candidate elected shall		
16	be installed at the next regular or special meeting of the City Council, or if the resigning member		
17	is still seated, the next regular or special meeting following the effective date of the resignation.		
18	The effective date of the resignation and installation of the elected candidate can occur at the		
19	same meeting, provided the resignation occurs before the installation. The candidate receiving a		
20	majority of the votes cast shall assume office forthwith. The election shall be held no later than		
21	60 days after the v	vacancy occurs. Insofar as possible, the The primary and election shall be called	
22	and conducted in a	accordance with G.S. 163A-1592 and the remainder of the laws governing other	
23	municipal elections in the City of Winston-Salem. Winston-Salem, as modified by the following		
24	provisions:		
25	(1)	The special primary and election shall be conducted and the results of the	
26		election determined in accordance with the partisan primary and election	
27		method set out in G.S. 163A-1615.	
28	<u>(2)</u>	The Forsyth County Board of Elections shall set the date and time candidates	
29		seeking party nomination may file notices of candidacy, provided that the	
30		filing period opens within 14 business days after the adoption of the resolution	
31		and is open for 14 business days. Each candidate shall be a resident of the	
32		ward which the vacating member represented.	
33	<u>(3)</u>	The Forsyth County Board of Elections shall hold the primary election no later	
34		than 60 calendar days after the close of the filing period, or as soon thereafter	
35		as practicable, and shall allow for absentee ballots to be applied for and cast.	



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<u>(4)</u>	The Forsyth County Board of Elections shall hold the ge	neral election no later	
	than 60 calendar days after the primary, or as soon the	reafter as practicable,	
	and shall allow for absentee ballots to be applied for a	and cast. A space for
