A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY TO CERTAIN SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN

## 4 5 Schools, Robeson County Schools, and Whiteville City Schools should be able to schedule school 6 opening and closing dates for any school located in those local school administrative units to 7 coincide with the opening and closing dates of Southeastern Community College; and 8 9 Schools, Columbus County Schools, Robeson County Schools, and Whiteville City Schools who 10 are enrolled in classes through Southeastern Community College by allowing them to align their 11 fall and spring semesters with the fall and spring semesters at Southeastern Community College; 12 and 13 14 County Schools, Robeson County Schools, Whiteville City Schools, and Southeastern Community 15 College to meet the workforce development needs in Bladen, Columbus, and Robeson Counties 16 more effectively than the current structure by helping high school and college students develop the 17 skills necessary for business and industry; Now, therefore,

18 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

ADOPTING THE SCHOOL CALENDAR.

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SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:

20 "(d) Opening and Closing Dates. - Local boards of education shall determine the dates of 21 opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except for 22 year round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than the Monday closest to 23 August 26, and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday closest to June 11. On 24 a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the requirement that the 25 opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26 and may allow the 26 local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the Monday closest to August 19, to 27 the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate anticipated 28 makeup days due to school closings. A local board may revise the scheduled closing date if 29 necessary in order to comply with the minimum requirements for instructional days or 30 instructional time. For purposes of this subsection, the term "good cause" means that schools in 31 any local school administrative unit in a county have been closed eight days per year during any 32 four of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or 33 other emergency situations.

34 The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school that 35 a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to any



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1 school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of modified

2 calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar."

3 SECTION 2. This act applies only to Bladen County Schools, Columbus County
4 Schools, Robeson County Schools, and Whiteville City Schools.

5 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2017-2018 school year.
