4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 105-275(45) reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 105-275. Property classified and excluded from the tax base.
7	The following classes of property are designated special classes under Article V, Sec. 2(2), of
8	the North Carolina Constitution and are excluded from tax:
9	
10	(45) Eighty percent (80%) Sixty percent (60%) of the appraised value of a solar
11	energy electric system. For purposes of this subdivision, the term "solar energy
12	electric system" means all equipment used directly and exclusively for the
13	conversion of solar energy to electricity."
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2017, and applies to taxes imposed
15	for taxable years beginning on or after that date.
