2	AN ACT ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF CORONER IN AVERY, BLADEN, HOKE, AND
3	MONTGOMERY COUNTIES.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.(a)</b> The office of coroner in Montgomery County is abolished.
6	<b>SECTION 1.(b)</b> Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable to
7	Montgomery County.
8	<b>SECTION 2.(a)</b> The office of coroner is abolished.
9	<b>SECTION 2.(b)</b> Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable.
10	<b>SECTION 2.(c)</b> This section applies only in the following counties: Avery, Bladen,
11	and Hoke Counties.
12	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Notwithstanding Section 2 of this act, any coroner elected in the 2018
13	or 2020 general election shall serve the remainder of their term. If a vacancy occurs in the office
14	of coroner, a person may be appointed to serve the remainder of the unexpired term.
15	<b>SECTION 4.</b> Sections 2 and 3 of this act become effective January 1, 2021. The
16	remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
