1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO ADOPT ICE CREAM AS THE OFFICIAL STATE FROZEN TREAT.
3	Whereas, the month of July is celebrated as National Ice Cream Month and the third
4	Sunday in July is celebrated as National Ice Cream Day; and
5	Whereas, ice cream is consumed by approximately 90% of the population in the
6	United States; and
7	Whereas, according to recent data, ice cream contributes about \$39 billion to the
8	United States' economy and produces almost 188,000 jobs; and
9	Whereas, ice cream can be combined with other foods such as fruit and sauces to
10	create a variety of other treats; and
11	Whereas, ice cream is important to the North Carolina dairy industry and is locally
12	produced all across the State by dairy farmers, creameries, family-owned businesses, and North
13	Carolina State University; and
14	Whereas, North Carolina does not have an official frozen treat; Now, therefore,
15	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
16	SECTION 1. Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
17	section to read:
18	"§ 145-52. State frozen treat.
19	Ice cream is adopted as the official frozen treat of the State of North Carolina."
20	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
