6	SECTION 1. G.S. 136-26 reads as rewritten:	
7	"§ 136-26. Closing of State transportation infrastructure during construction; constru	iction
8	or for dangerous conditions; driving through, removal, injury to bar	
9	warning signs, etc.)
10	If it shall appear necessary to the Department of Transportation, its officers, or appro	priate
11	employees, to close any transportation infrastructure coming under its jurisdiction so as to	+
12	proper completion of <u>construction</u> work which is being performed, <u>or to prohibit traf</u>	-
13	transportation infrastructure due to damage posing a danger to public safety, the Departm	
14	Transportation, its officers or employees, may close, or cause to be closed, the whole of	
15	portion of transportation infrastructure deemed necessary to be excluded from public	•
16	While any transportation infrastructure, or portion thereof, is so closed, or while	
17	transportation infrastructure, or portion thereof, is in process of construction or maintenand	
18	Department of Transportation, its officers or appropriate employees, or its contractor,	
19	authority from the Department of Transportation, may erect, or cause to be erected, su	
20	barriers or obstruction thereon; may post, or cause to be posted, conspicuous notices to the	
21	that the transportation infrastructure, or portion thereof, is closed; and may place warning	
22	lights and lanterns on transportation infrastructure, or portions thereof. When infrastructure	-
23	closed to the public or in process of construction or maintenance, as provided herein, any	
24	who willfully drives into new construction work, breaks down, onto transportation infrastr	ucture
25	closed pursuant to this section or removes, injures or destroys any such barrier or barrier	
26	obstructions on the road closed or being constructed, or tears down, removes or destroy	
27	such notices, or extinguishes, removes, injures or destroys any such warning lights signs,	
28	or lanterns so erected, posted or placed, posted, or placed pursuant to this section, shall be	guilty
29	of a Class 1 misdemeanor.	
30	This prohibition does not apply to law enforcement, first responders, personnel of emer	gency
31	management agencies, or Department of Transportation personnel acting in the course of	
32	within the scope of, their official duties; or personnel acting in the course of, and within the	
33	of, installation, restoration or maintenance of utility services in coordination with the Depart	
34	of Transportation."	
35	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2019, and applies to of	fenses
36	committed on or after that date.	



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
