The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 75-102 reads as rewritten:

"§ 75-102. Restrictions on telephone solicitations.

(i) No telephone solicitor shall knowingly use any method to block or otherwise circumvent a telephone subscriber's use of a caller identification service. cause misleading information to be transmitted to users of caller identification technologies, or otherwise block or misrepresent the origin of the telephone solicitation. No provider of telephone caller identification services shall be held liable for violations of this subsection committed by other individuals or entities. It is not a violation of this subsection for a telephone solicitor to utilize the name and number of the entity the solicitation is being made on behalf of rather than the name and number of the telephone solicitor.
