A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT REMOVING CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM THE CORPORATE  
LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF BOLTON.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of S.L. 2005-141 is repealed, and the property added to the corporate limits of the Town of Bolton in that Section is removed from the Town's corporate limits.

**SECTION 2.** This act has no effect upon the validity of any liens of the Town of Bolton for ad valorem taxes or special assessments outstanding before the effective date of this act. Such liens may be collected or foreclosed upon after the effective date of this act as though the property were still within the corporate limits of the Town of Bolton.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective June 30, 2019. Property in the territory described in Section 2 of S.L. 2005-141 as of January 1, 2019, is no longer subject to municipal taxes for taxes imposed for taxable years beginning on or after July 1, 2019.
