A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO SUSPEND DEVELOPMENT OF THE NORTH CAROLINA FAMILIES ACCESSING SERVICES THROUGH TECHNOLOGY (NC FAST) SYSTEM AS RELATED TO CASE-MANAGEMENT FUNCTIONALITY FOR THE CHILD WELFARE SYSTEM AND AGING AND ADULT SERVICES' PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Social Services, shall suspend development of the North Carolina Families Accessing Services Through Technology (NC FAST) system as it relates to case-management functionality for the child welfare system and aging and adult services' programs. The Division shall not expand the child welfare case management component of the NC FAST system statewide, but shall instead continue to develop and improve case-management functionality for the child welfare component of NC FAST only in those counties that participated in the initial pilot program prior to January 1, 2019.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
