32	Governor under G.S. 90-625(a)(4), as enacted by Section 1 of this act, shall begin on July 1,		
33	2019, and shall expire on June 30, 2022. If at the time of the appointment, the Board has not		
34	begun to issue any licenses to operate a massage and bodywork therapy establishment, the		
35	appointee shall be a current owner of a massage and bodywork therapy establishment.		
36	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
