The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 143C-5-2, there is appropriated from the		
General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) in		
recurring funds for the 2019-2020 fiscal year to be transferred to the nonprofit corporation with		
which the Department of Commerce has contracted pursuant to the authority granted in		
G.S. 143B-431.01(b). The nonprofit corporation shall utilize the transferred funds in the
