1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR REPAIRS TO MURRAY'S MILL, A NATIONAL 3 REGISTER HISTORIC SITE IN CATAWBA COUNTY. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) in 6 7 nonrecurring funds for the 2022-2023 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to the Catawba County Historical Association, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, for repairs to Murray's Mill, which 8 9 is listed as a National Register Historic Site. These funds may be used for repairs to Murray's Mill, including the water wheel, buckets, and flume; maintenance of the old bridge; and 10 construction of a building for a farmers market and other events. 11

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2022.
