Short Title: (Public) Booking Photograph Privacy Act. Representative Moffitt. Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE RELEASE OF BOOKING PHOTOGRAPHS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 132-1.4 reads as rewritten: "§ 132-1.4. Criminal investigations; intelligence information records; Innocence Inquiry Commission records. As used in this section: (b) (6) "Booking photograph" means an image of an individual taken by an arresting public law enforcement agency for the purpose of identification or taken when the individual was processed into a jail. . . . Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and except as otherwise provided in this (m) subsection, booking photographs are confidential, are not public records as defined in G.S. 132-1, and public law enforcement agencies are prohibited from publishing, distributing, or releasing booking photographs. A public law enforcement agency may release a booking photograph only when the booking photograph is a record of criminal investigation related to a missing person report. A court of competent jurisdiction may order the release of a booking photograph upon a showing by the person requesting disclosure that the disclosure is actually necessary for
