Any such required equipment shall be maintained in proper working order. The operator of and all 13 14 passengers on a modified utility vehicle that is not equipped with a windshield and windshield wipers shall wear a safety helmet, with a retention strap 15 16 properly secured, that complies with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 17 (FMVSS) 218. 18 19 The Notwithstanding the provisions of any other subdivision of this section, (4) 20 the Department of Transportation may prohibit the operation of low-speed 21 vehicles, mini-trucks, or modified utility vehicles on any road or highway if it 22 determines that the prohibition is necessary in the interest of safety. 23
