5	(a) Subject to the provisions of subsections (a1) and (d) of this section, the amount of the		
6	grant awarded in each case shall be a percentage of the withholdings of eligible positions for a		
7	period of years. The percentage shall be no more than eighty percent (80%) for a development		
8	tier one area and no more than seventy-five percent (75%) for any other area. If the project will		
9	be located in more than one area designation, the location with the highest area designation		
10	determines the maximum percentage to be used. The percentage used to determine the amount		
11	of the grant shall be based on criteria developed by the Committee, in consultation with the		
12	Attorney General, after considering at least the following:
