| 3 | TO ALIGN THEIR SCHOOL CALENDARS WITH SURRY COUNTY COMMUNITY |
| 4 | COLLEGE'S OR DAVIDSON-DAVIE COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S CALENDAR. |
| 5 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten: |
| 7 | "(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the dates of |
| 8 | opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except for |
| 9 | year-round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than the Monday closest to |
| 10 | August 26, and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday closest to June 11. |
| 11 | On a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the requirement that the |
| 12 | opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26 and may allow the |
| 13 | local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the Monday closest to August 19, |
| 14 | to the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate anticipated |
| 15 | makeup days due to school closings. A local board may revise the scheduled closing date if |
| 16 | necessary in order to comply with the minimum requirements for instructional days or |
| 17 | instructional time. For purposes of this subsection, the term "good cause" means that schools in |
| 18 | any local school administrative unit in a county have been closed eight days per year during any |
| 19 | four of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, |
| 20 | or other emergency situations. |
| 21 | The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school |
| 22 | that a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to |
| 23 | any school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of |
| 24 | modified calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar. |
| 25 | Notwithstanding the required opening and closing dates under this subsection, a local board |
| 26 | of education may align the calendar of schools in the local school administrative unit with the |
| 27 | calendar of a community college serving in the city or county in which the unit is located." |
| 28 | SECTION 2. This act applies only to Yadkin County Schools and Davie County |
| 29 | Schools. |
| 30 | SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with |
| 31 | the 2023-2024 school year. |
