SECTION 1. Chapter 81A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new

The standard time of the State and its political subdivisions is the time designated by the

SECTION 2. Within 60 days of Congress authorizing the states to observe Daylight

United States Department of Transportation pursuant to the Uniform Time Act of 1966 (15

U.S.C. §§ 260-267). If authorized by Congress, the State and its political subdivisions shall observe Daylight Saving Time, as provided in 15 U.S.C. § 260a, at all times throughout the year."

Saving Time throughout the year, the Commissioner of Agriculture shall notify the Governor, who, by executive order or otherwise, shall implement G.S. 81A-100, as enacted by this act.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
