Short Title: Unfair Real Estate Agreements Act. (Public) Sponsors: Referred to: March 22, 2023 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT UNFAIR REAL ESTATE SERVICE AGREEMENTS FOR 3 RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 93A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 6 Article to read: 7 "Article 7. 8 "Prohibition of Unfair Real Estate Service Agreements. 9 "§ 93A-85.1. Purpose; definitions. 10 This Article is intended to prohibit the use of real estate service agreements that are (a) unfair to an owner of residential real estate or to other persons who may become owners of that 11 real estate in the future. This Article also prohibits the recording of such residential real estate 12 service agreements so that the public records will not be clouded by them and provides remedies 13 for owners who are inconvenienced or damaged by the recording of such agreements. 14 For the purposes of this Article, the following definitions apply: 15 (b) Person. - A person as defined in G.S. 105-228.90(b)(23). 16 (1) Real estate service agreement. – A written contract between a service provider 17 (2)18 and the owner or potential buyer of residential real estate to provide services, current or future, in connection with the maintenance, purchase, or sale of 19 20 residential real estate. Residential real estate. - Real property located in this State which is used 21 (3) 22 primarily for personal, family, or household purposes. 23 Service provider. – A person who provides a service related to residential real (4) 24 estate, including a real estate broker. Unfair real estate service agreement. - A real estate service agreement that 25 (5)violates G.S. 93A-85.2. 26 "§ 93A-85.2. Unfair real estate service agreements. 27 Unfair Real Estate Service Agreements. – A real estate service agreement is unfair, 28 (a) void, and in violation of this Article if the agreement is to be in effect for more than one year and 29 30 either expressly or implicitly aims to do any of the following: 31 Run with the land or bind future owners of residential real estate identified in (1)32 the real estate service agreement. Allow for assignment of the right to provide services without notice or consent 33 (2)
