A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AMENDING THE LABOR LAWS TO REQUIRE EMPLOYERS TO POST NOTICE OF VETERANS' BENEFITS.		
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Article 1 of Chapter 95 of the General Statutes is amended by adding		
a new section to read:		
"§ 95-9.2. Employers to post notice of veterans' benefits.		
(a) It shall be the duty of every employer to keep posted in a conspicuous place in every		
room where five or more persons are employed a printed notice stating the provisions of the law relative to veterans' benefits in this State. The Commissioner of Labor shall furnish a digital form		
on its website or the printed form of the notice upon request. At a minimum, the form shall		
include information about the following services for veterans:
