1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT CREATING THE SHANNON LEIGH ADCOCK, STEVEN ANTHONY CHRISTOS,
3	AND SAMANTHA DAVIS MEMORIAL ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SECOND WEEK
4	IN NOVEMBER AS SUDEP AWARENESS WEEK IN THE STATE OF NORTH
5	CAROLINA AND TO RECOMMEND AWARENESS TRAINING FOR SCHOOL
6	PERSONNEL RESPONSIBLE FOR STUDENTS WITH EPILEPSY OR OTHERWISE
7	PREDISPOSED TO SEIZURES.
8	Whereas, "SUDEP" is the sudden, unexpected death of a person with epilepsy who
9	was otherwise considered healthy; and
10	Whereas, each year, more than one out of 1,000 people with epilepsy die from
11	SUDEP; and
12	Whereas, uncontrolled seizures increase the risk of SUDEP to more than one out of
13	150 people; and
14	Whereas, November is observed as National Epilepsy Awareness Month throughout
15	the nation; and
16	Whereas, during National Epilepsy Awareness Month, it is important to also bring
17	awareness of SUDEP; Now, therefore,
18	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
19	SECTION 1. Chapter 103 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
20	section to read:
21	" <u>§ 103-17. SUDEP Awareness Week.</u>
22	The week beginning on the second Sunday in November of each year is designated as Sudden
23	Unexpected Death in Epilepsy (SUDEP) Awareness Week in North Carolina."
24	<b>SECTION 2.</b> Article 25A of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by
25	adding a new section to read:
26	" <u>§ 115C-375.7. Seizure awareness training for school personnel.</u>
27	(a) This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Shannon Leigh Adcock, Steven
28	Anthony Christos, and Samantha Davis Memorial Act."
29	(b) It is the goal of the General Assembly to encourage local boards of education to
30	develop and provide seizure awareness training for all teachers and other school personnel who
31	may be responsible for students with epilepsy or students that are otherwise predisposed to
32	seizures."
33	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
