Short Title: (Public) Economic Stability Act. Representative Everitt. Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ENACT THE ECONOMIC STABILITY ACT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Economic Stability Act." **SECTION 2.** Article 3 of Chapter 95 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 95-31.1. Economic Stability Act. <u>Definitions</u>. – The following definitions apply in this section: (a) Call center employer or employer. – Any business that employs 200 or more (1) employees, excluding part-time employees, for the purpose of customer service or back-office operations. Commissioner. – The Commissioner of Labor. **(2)** Notice Requirements. – A call center employer that intends to relocate a call center, (b) or one or more facilities or operating units within a call center comprising at least seventy percent (70%) of the call center's or operating unit's total volume, must notify the Commissioner and the employer's employees at least 15 days prior to the relocation." **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to relocations
