A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE EXCUSED ABSENCES FROM PUBLIC SCHOOL FOR PARTICIPATION IN 4-H ACTIVITIES OR PROGRAMS.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-379(b) reads as rewritten:  "(b) In addition to any excused absences authorized pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, the rules shall require school principals to authorize the following excused absences:		
(1	Religious observance. – A minimum of two excused absences each acade year for religious observances required by the faith of a student or the student or legal guardian.

The rules may require that the student's parent or legal guardian give the principal written notice of the request for an excused absence a reasonable time prior to the religious observance or military leave. absence authorized by this subsection. The student shall be given the opportunity to make up any tests or other work missed due to an excused absence for a religious

- 3 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2024-2025 school year.
