Referred to: Judiciary 2, if favorable, Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House April 19, 2023 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REPLACE THE CRIME OF FELONY COMMON LAW OBSTRUCTION OF JUSTICE WITH A CODIFIED VERSION OF THAT SAME CRIME. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 30 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-222.1. Obstruction of justice. If any person shall, with deceit and an intent to defraud, unlawfully obstruct justice, the person is guilty of a Class I felony. This crime shall replace the crime of common law felony

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2023, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
