AN ACT TO REDUCE PARENT COPAYMENTS FOR SUBSIDIZED CHILD CARE AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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**SECTION 1.** Section 9C.4(b) of S.L. 2021-180 reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 9C.4.(b) Fees for families who are required to share in the cost of care are established based on ten percent (10%) seven percent (7%) of gross family income. When care is received at the blended rate, the copayment shall be eighty-three percent (83%) of the full-time copayment. Copayments for part-time care shall be seventy-five percent (75%) of the full-time copayment."

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child Development and Early Education, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for each year of the 2023-2025 fiscal biennium to assist with administrative costs associated with implementing Section 1 of this act.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2023.
